Background: Olfactory receptors interact with odorant molecules in the nose, to initiate a neuronal response that triggers the perception of a smell. The olfactory receptor proteins are members of a large family of G-protein-coupled receptors (GPCR) arising from single coding-exon genes. Olfactory receptors share a 7-transmembrane domain structure with many neurotransmitter and hormone receptors and are responsible for the recognition and G protein-mediated transduction of odorant signals. The olfactory receptor gene family is the largest in the genome. The nomenclature assigned to the olfactory receptor genes and proteins for this organism is independent of other organisms. Format: Lyophilized

Storage: RT/-20 °C

Storage Comment:

- Keep the vial sealed and store at -20°C for long-term storage.
- Before use, centrifuge the vial at 6,000 g x g for 1 minute at 4°C.
- Open the lid and add 100 µl (or other volume depending on your desired final concentration) of distilled water (or TE buffer) to dissolve the DNA.
- If necessary, heat the solution at 50°C for 15 minutes to dissolve the DNA.
- Close the lid and vortex the vial for 1 minute.
- Aliquot the dissolved plasmid DNA and store in small aliquots at -20°C.
