Background: Defensins form a family of microbicidal and cytotoxic peptides made by neutrophils. Members of the defensin family are highly similar in protein sequence. Format: Lyophilized

Storage: RT/-20 °C

Storage Comment:

- Keep the vial sealed and store at -20°C for long-term storage.
- Before use, centrifuge the vial at 6,000 g x g for 1 minute at 4°C.
- Open the lid and add 100 µl (or other volume depending on your desired final concentration) of distilled water (or TE buffer) to dissolve the DNA.
- If necessary, heat the solution at 50°C for 15 minutes to dissolve the DNA.
- Close the lid and vortex the vial for 1 minute.
- Aliquot the dissolved plasmid DNA and store in small aliquots at -20°C.
